



St. Tammany Parish Development District opens applications for candidates to serve on Board of Commissioners

The St. Tammany Parish Development District Nominating Committee will accept and review resumes and questionnaires from applicants interested in serving on its Board of Commissioners to fill three expiring seats. All applicants must be qualified voters and taxpayers within St. Tammany Parish. Terms will begin January 1, 2025, and run through December 31, 2027.

The District is a political subdivision of the State of Louisiana, created by the Legislature to foster business and economic development in St. Tammany Parish and operates under the Louisiana Code of Governmental Ethics. The Board of Commissioners holds regular meetings, generally on the third Thursday of every month.

The position requires a commitment of time, submission of an annual Tier 2.1 Financial Disclosure, nondisclosure agreement, ethics training, sexual harassment prevention training, family roster, a background check, and a willingness to invest knowledge, expertise, and service.

Candidates of particular interest are those with expertise in economic development, business development, business management, legal, finance, real estate, transportation, logistics and advance manufacturing.
